Appeal for witnesses to burglary in Hythe Road, Worthing

Police are appealing for witnesses to a burglary which occurred at a house in Hythe Road, Worthing, between 5.20pm and 9pm on Monday (13 November).

Items including two laptops, cash, bank cards and a diabetic blood testing kit were stolen.

PC David Slade said: "Some force must have been used in order to gain entry to the property, and there would have been some loud noises including the breaking of glass.

"We'd like to hear from anyone who heard or saw anything suspicious in the area around the time."

Man attacked and cash stolen from home in Worthing

A man was attacked in his home in Worthing by three masked people who stole a quantity of cash.

The house in Old Worthing Road, East Preston, was broken into around 7.45pm on Tuesday (November 14), disturbing the victim who challenged the men in the kitchen of the property.

He was pushed back into his living room on to a sofa and assaulted a number of times by a man who demanded money.

The trio were all dressed in black and wearing balaclavas that showed only their eyes. They were all around 6' and of medium build. The man who assaulted the victim was wearing black

Adidas-branded tracksuit bottoms.

They made their escape running east along Old Worthing Road, turning left into Arlington Crescent. About half-a-minute later, a silver Mercedes C Class without lights on drove out of the crescent and turned east.

Teenager arrested for drug offences in Worthing

A 16-year-old has been arrested on suspicion of possession with intent to supply class A drugs after a search in Worthing.

The teenager from Waltham Forest, London, was stop searched in Queen's Road on Sunday (November 12) after he was spotted leaving a property believed to be involved with drug offences.

During the search officers discovered over 100 wraps of believed to be crack cocaine and heroin, a small bag of cannabis and cash.

He was arrested and released under investigation on suspicion of possession with intent to supply class A drugs, acquire, use or possession of a criminal property and possession of a controlled class B drug (cannabis).
